10. Are you given enough opportunities to express your doubts, concerns and suggestions?

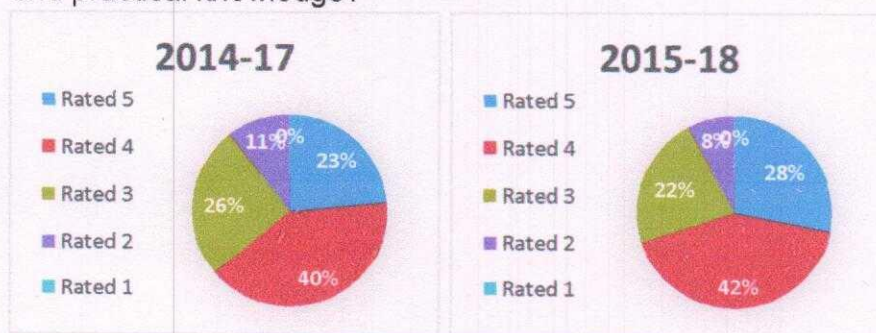

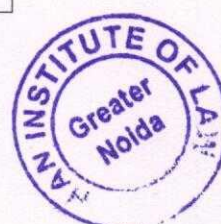

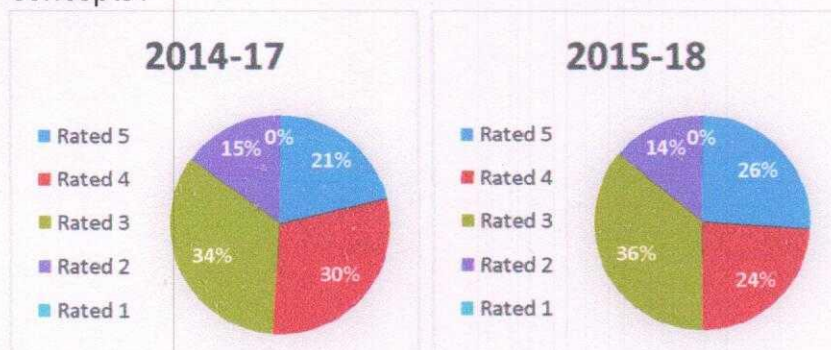
Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?

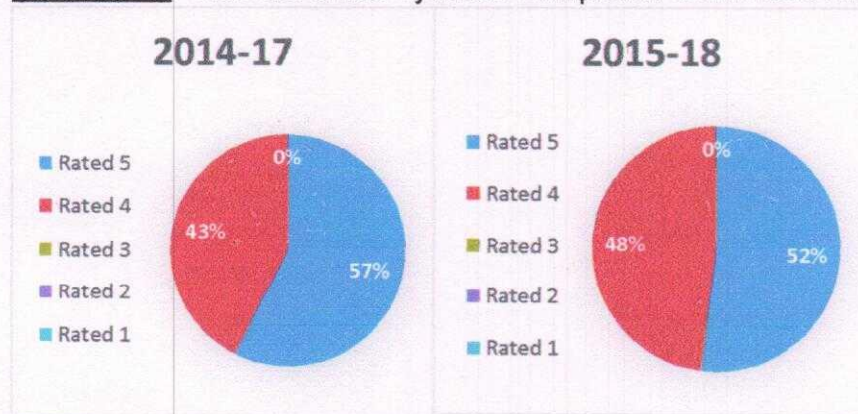


Question 2: The syllabus provides with adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?



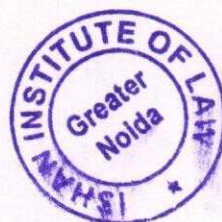

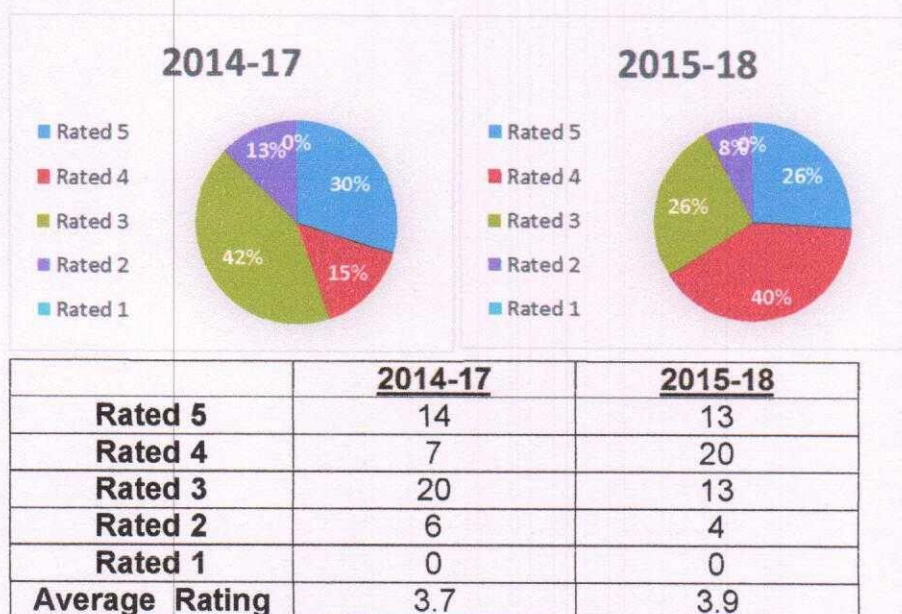
Question 3: Was the entire syllabus completed within time along with revision?



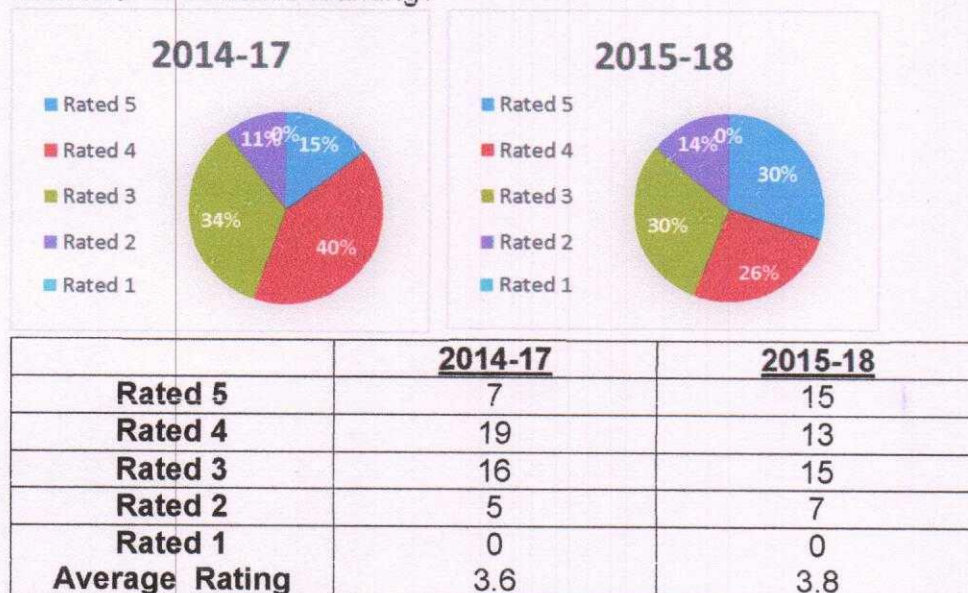

Question 4: The teachers provide the students opportunities to learn and grow?

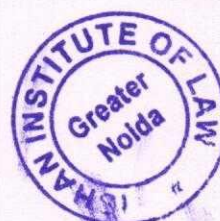


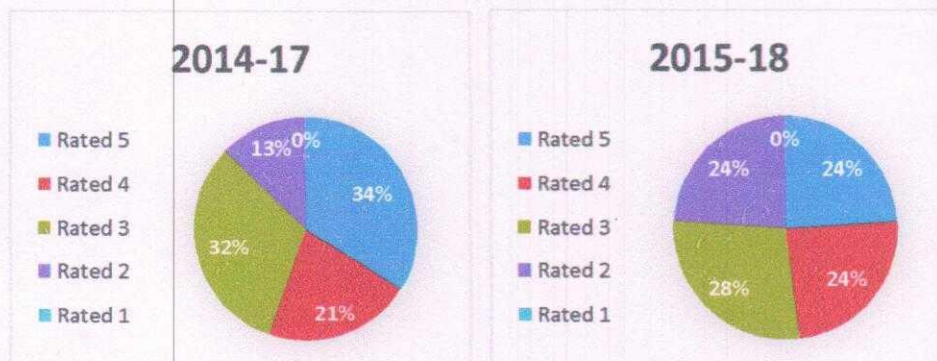


Question 5: How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?



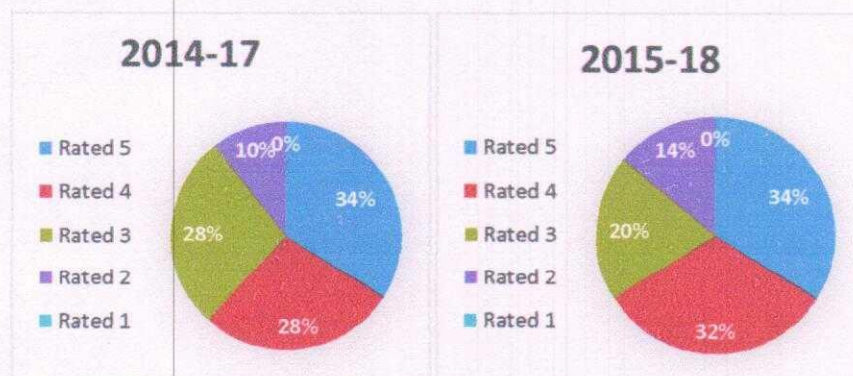
Question 6: Do you find the class room properly equipped to provide good atmosphere of learning along with necessary ICT tools?





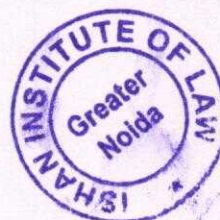

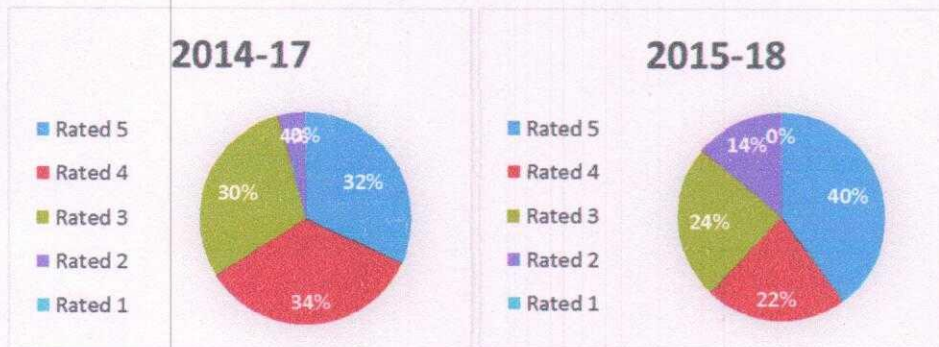
Question 7: Are you satisfied with the course and reference material available in the college library?

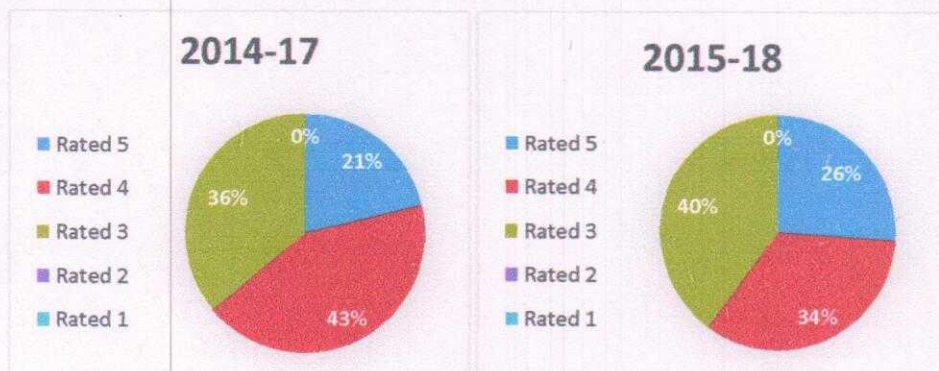
Question 8: Were you given enough opportunities and encouragement to participate in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities?





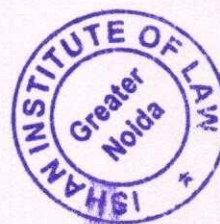

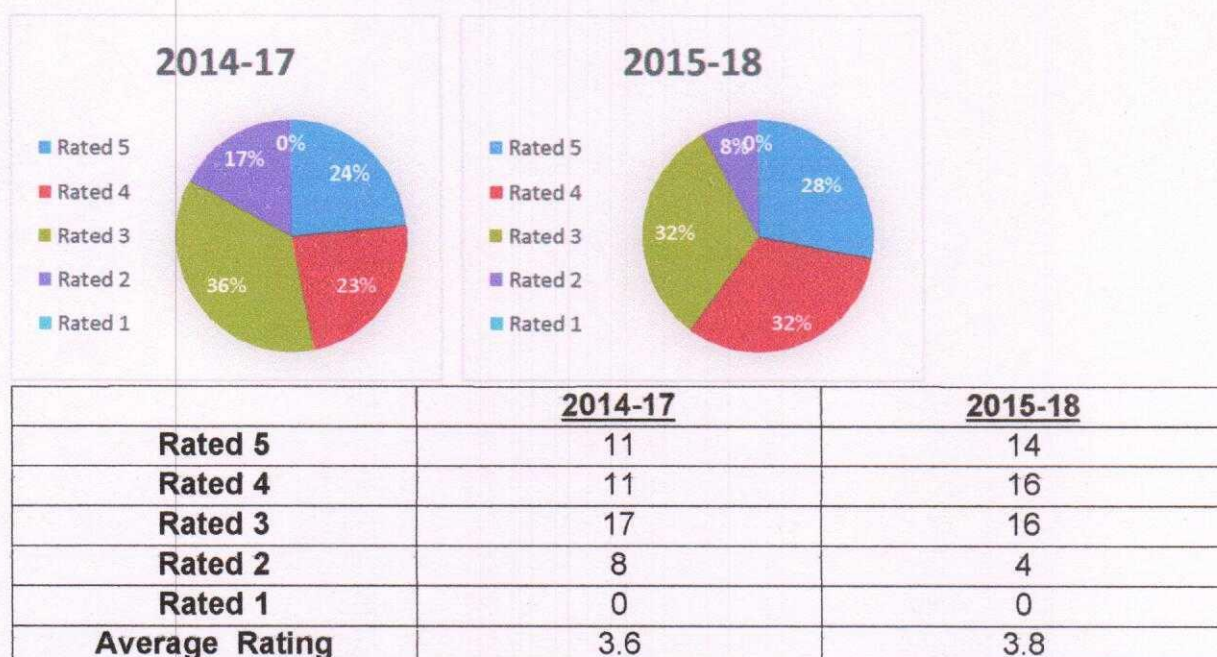
Question 9: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?

Overall Observation

1. It was imperative to see that 70 percent of the students rated 4 on the completion of syllabus on time followed by proper revision.
2. The students rated in between 4 and 5 in the adequacy of the knowledge of the fundamnet concepts of the respective subjects and also for the combination of the syllabus having both practical and theoretical approach.
3. Out of the students involved in the survey more than 80 percent rated 4 for providing with the opportunities to learn and grow by participating in extra-curricular activities such as moots, seminars, conferences, etc.
4. Some students feel ICT tools are inadequate.
5. More than 70 percent rated 4 for the opportunities given to express the doubts, concerns and suggestions related to subjects.
6. Above 70 percent students rated 4 for the reference material given to them by the concerned faculties.



Action Taken

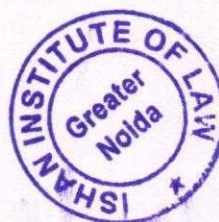
1. More reference books are added in the library for the students.

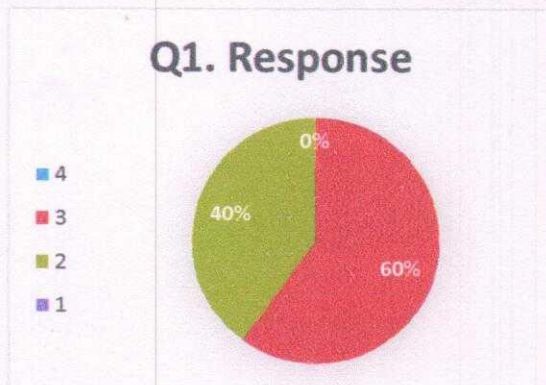

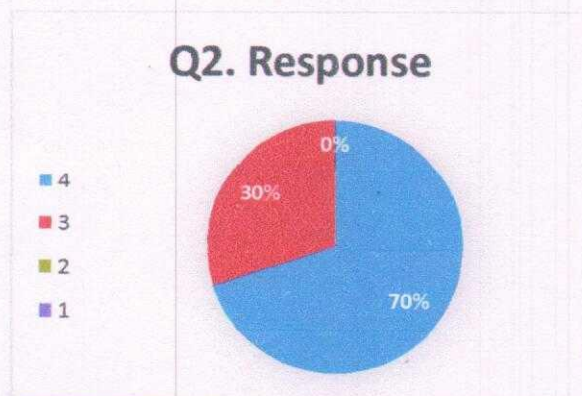

Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus provided by the university?



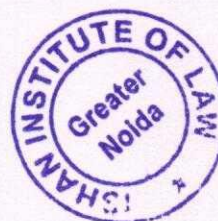

Question 2: Is the infrastructure provided to you by the college in class room satisfactory?

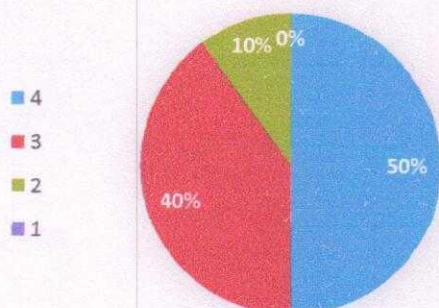

Question 3: What is your opinion on the facilities provided to you like Library and Reading Rooms?



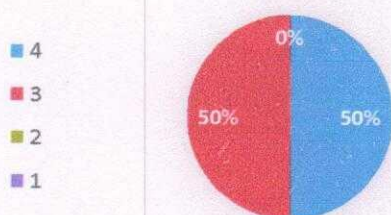

Question 4: According to you, are the co-curricular activities designed during the year 3.5 appropriate?

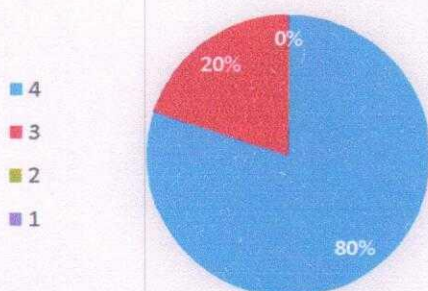

Question 5: How satisfied are you with the facilities given to you by the management?

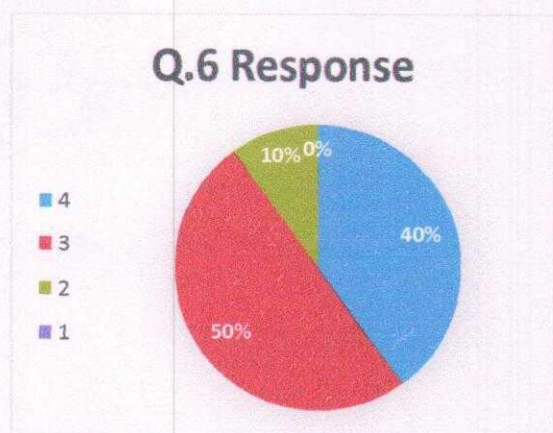

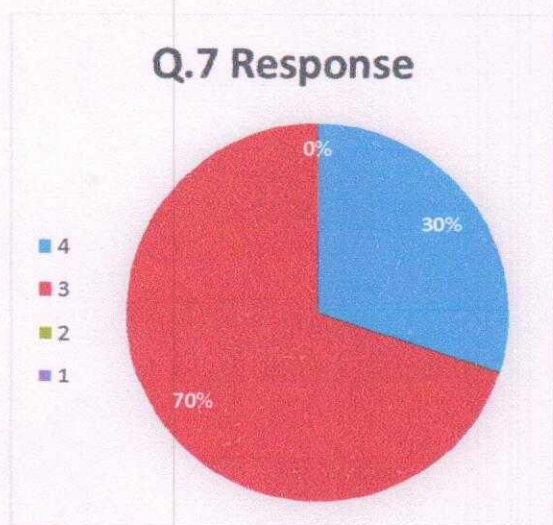


Question 6: Are you given proper opportunity to express your concern in the academic matters?

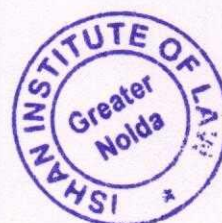
Question 7: How satisfied are you with the computer and internet facilities in the campus?

1. More than 70 percent of the Teachers rated 4 for the syllabus provided by the University and the infrastructure of the Institution such as classroom, library, Staff room, etc.






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2. Out of the teachers involved in the survey more than 75 percent of the faculties are satisfied with the library and the reading rooms.
