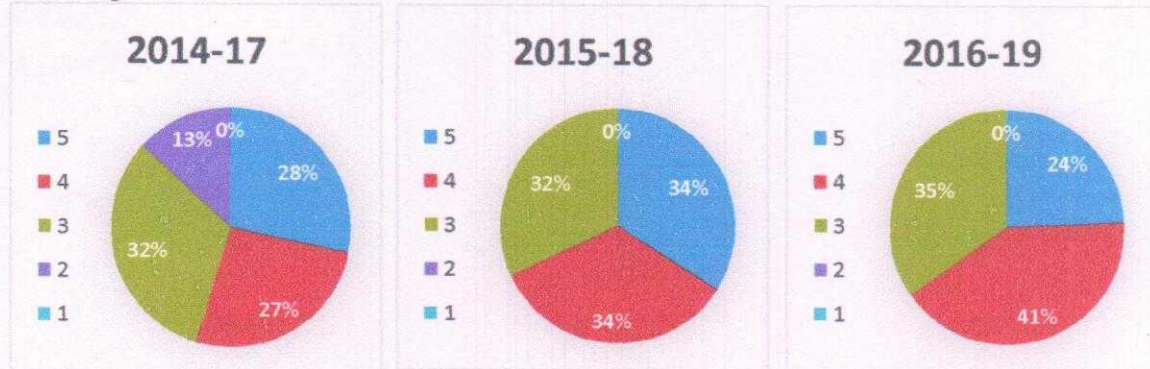

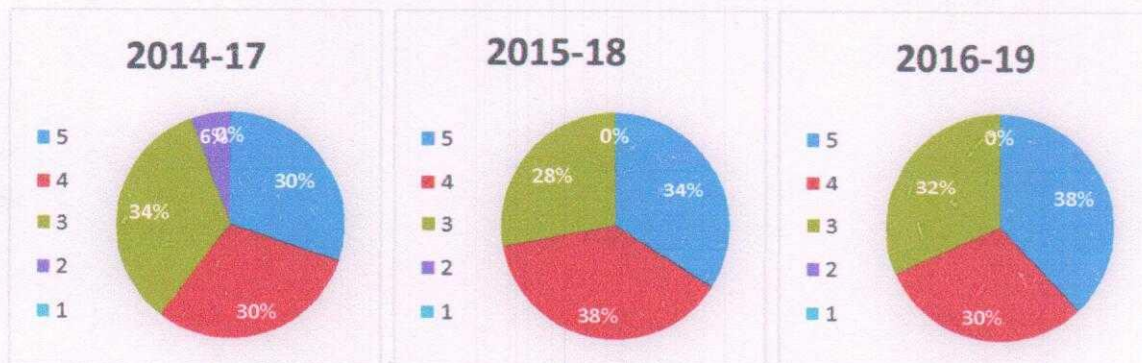

Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?

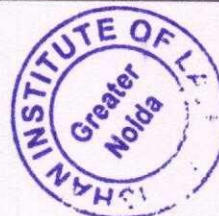

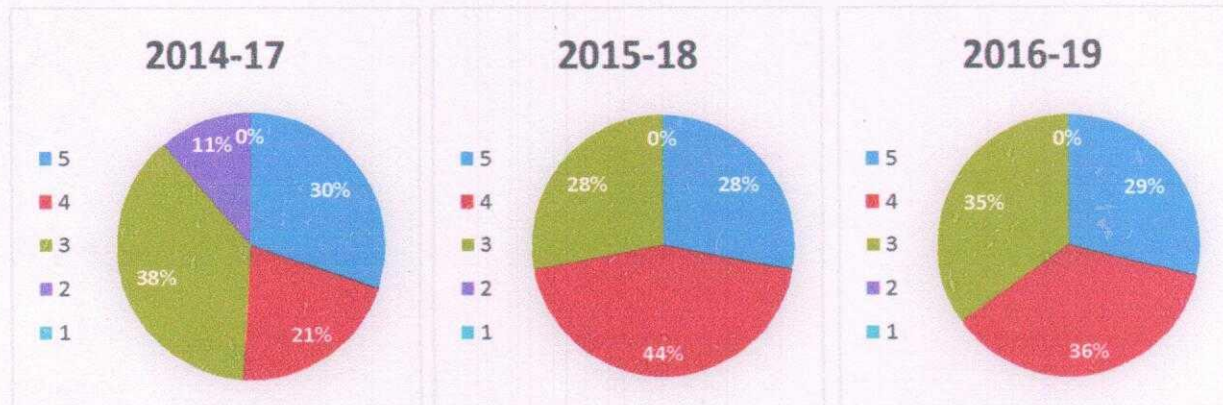
Question 2: The syllabus provides with adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?

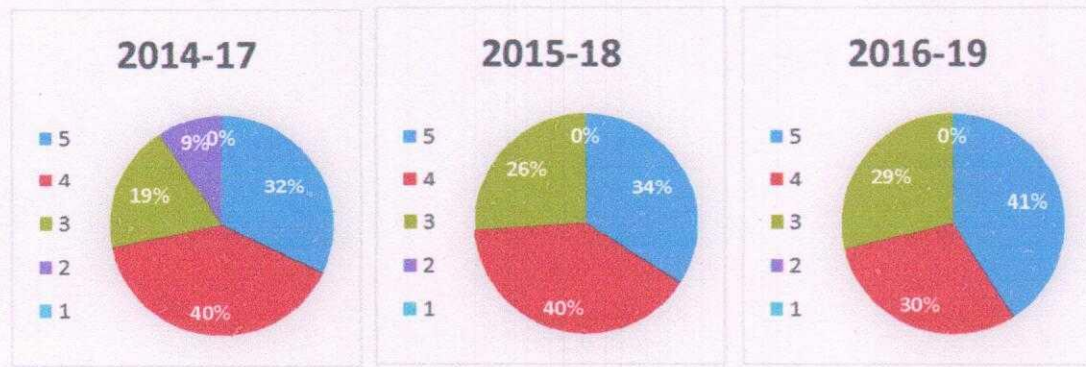


Question 3: Was the entire syllabus completed within time along with revision?

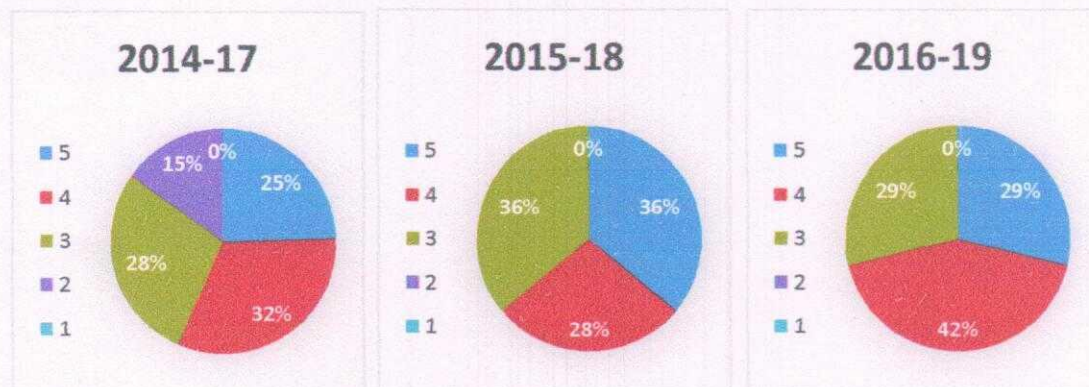
Question 4: The teachers provide the students opportunities to learn and grow?

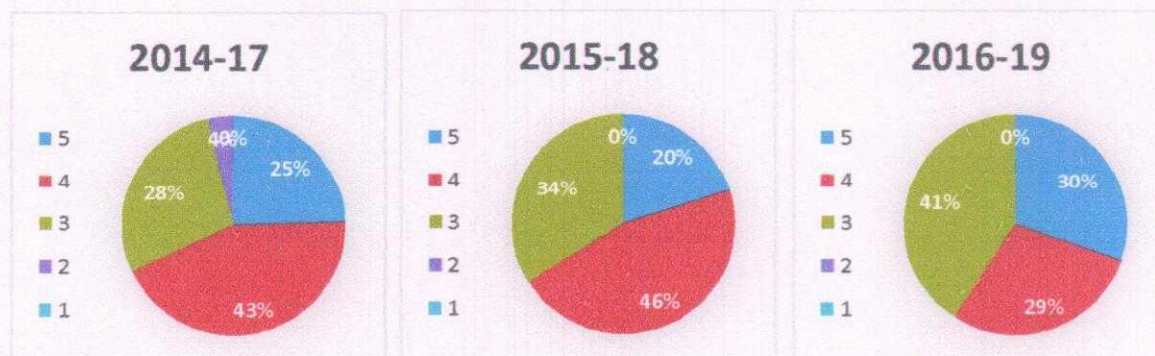


Question 5: How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?



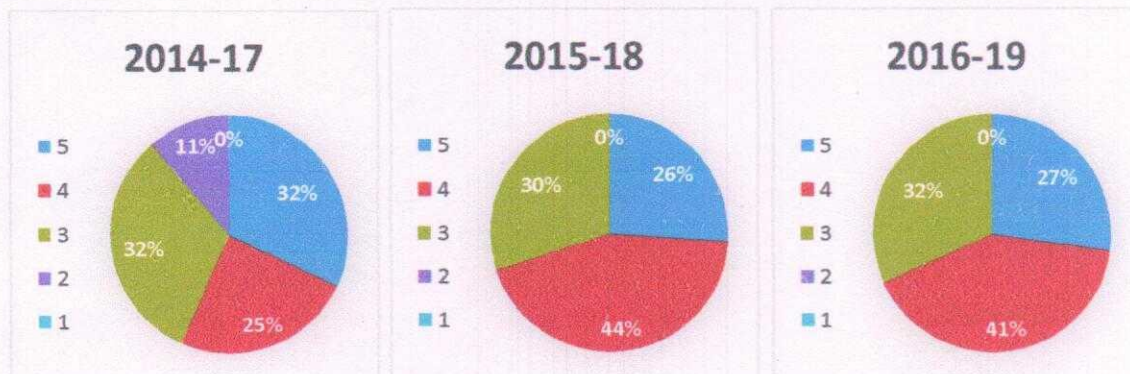

Question 6: Do you find the class room properly equipped to provide good atmosphere of learning along with necessary ICT tools?



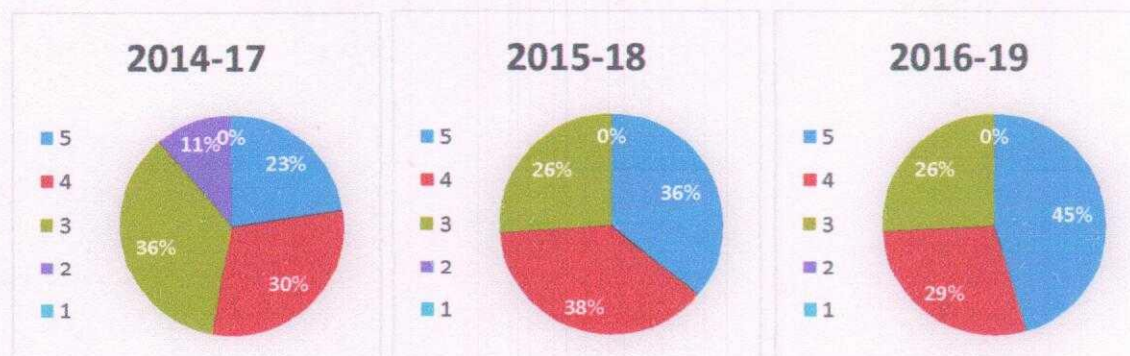

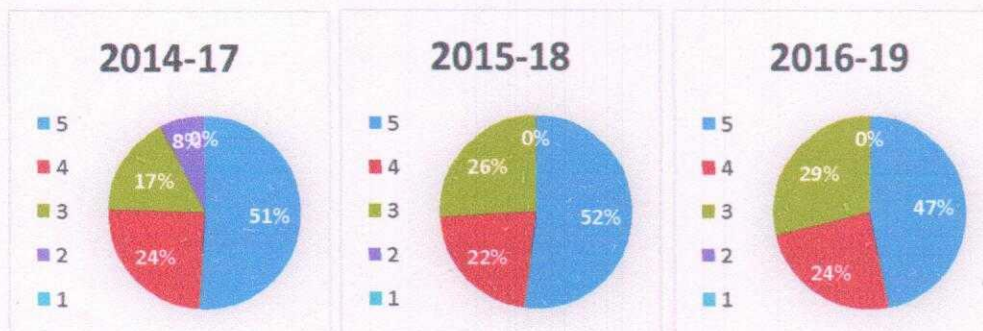
Question 8: Were you given enough opportunities and encouragement to participate in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities?

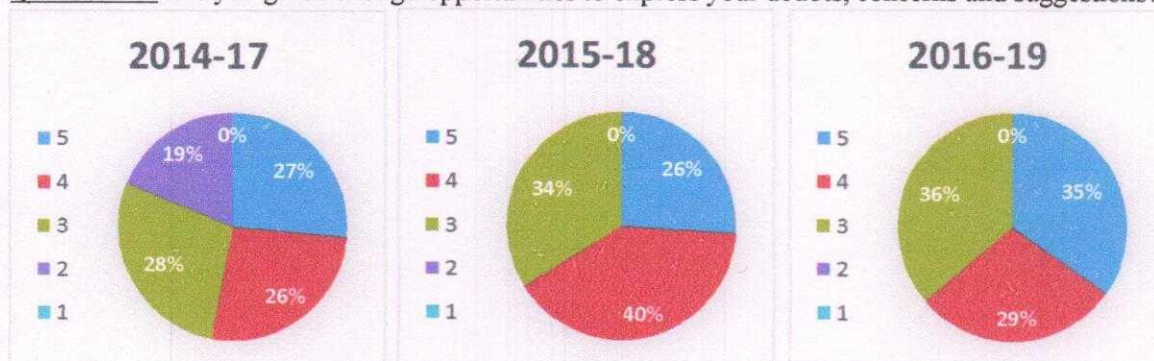

Overall Observation

1. According to the survey more than 70 percent of students of all the batch (2014-17, 2015-18, 2016-18) rated 4 on the combination of practical and theoretical aspects included in the Set of courses which helped them provide ample amount of knowledge and develop practical skills to excel in their field.
2. Out of the Students (Batch 2014-17, 2015-18, 2016-18) involved in the survey, it was more than 75 percent of the students who rated in between 4 and 5 on the completion of the syllabus within mentioned time framework.
3. More than 75 percent of the students rated 4 for the teaching Methodology used by the teachers in the Class.
4. More than 75 percent of the students are satisfied with the course and the reference material available in the college library and also the reading material provided by the respective Professors.
5. According to the Survey conducted it was concluded that more than 80 percent of the students are given opportunities and encouragement to participate in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities such as Seminar, conference, Quiz, Moot Courts, etc.
6. Above 75 percent of the students rated 4 on given the opportunities to clear their doubts, concerns and suggestions. Faculties are promptly available to direct with their various Concerns.

Action Taken

1. Though doubts and concerns of the Students are entertained by the professors on time, but still it was decided by the institutions to organize extra classes on Sundays for all those who are not able to grab quickly with an agenda to pay attention on each students.
2. The authority decided to add more reference books in the library for instigating effective research. The students are made to include empirical data in their projects
3. Various guest lectures by the experts were organized on contemporary topics for better understanding of the Students.
4. For inculcating and developing more of Practical approach in students, Field visits of Courts, guest lectures from practicing lawyers, legal aid camps were organised.

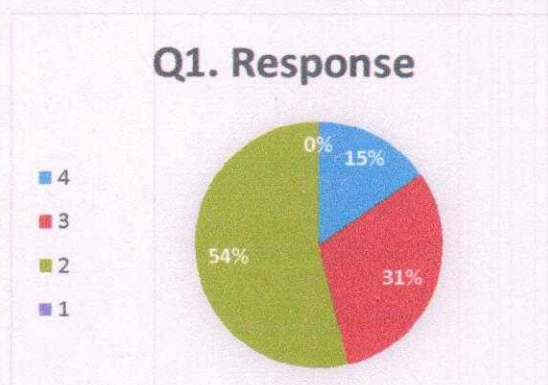

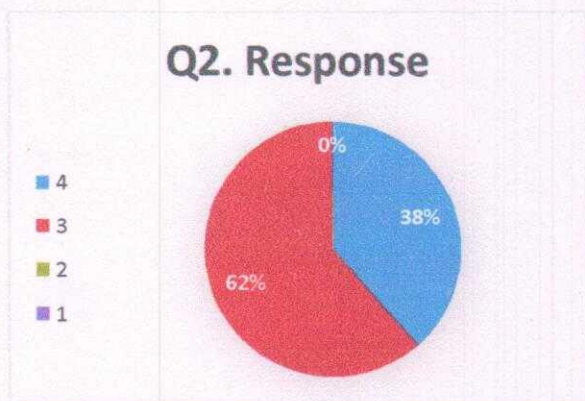
Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus provided by the university?

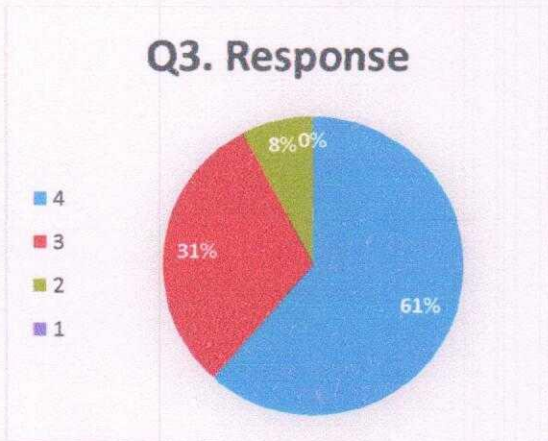


Question 2: Is the infrastructure provided to you by the college in class room satisfactory?



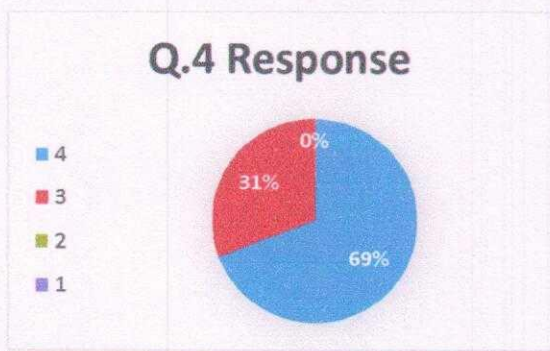

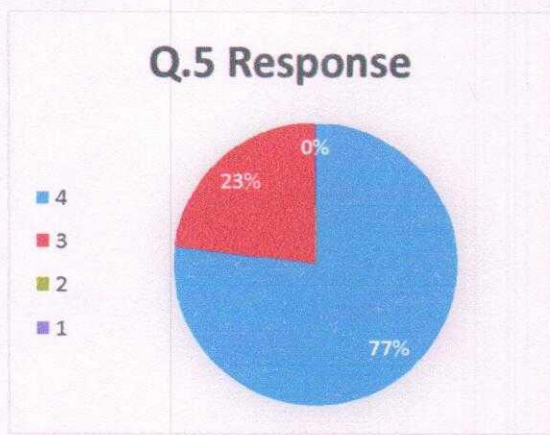
Question 4: According to you, are the co-curricular activities designed during the year appropriate?

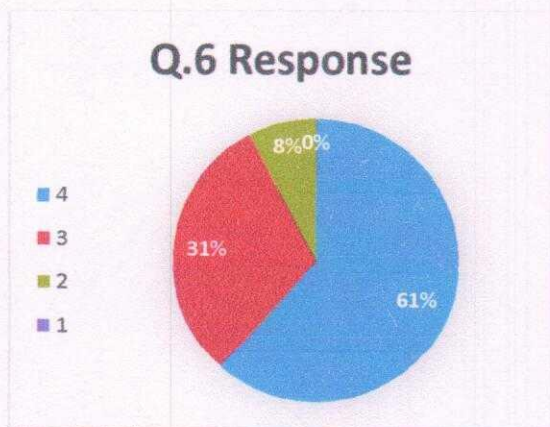


Question 5: How satisfied are you with the facilities given to you by the management?

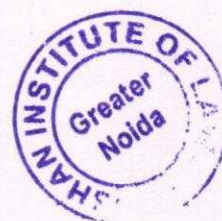

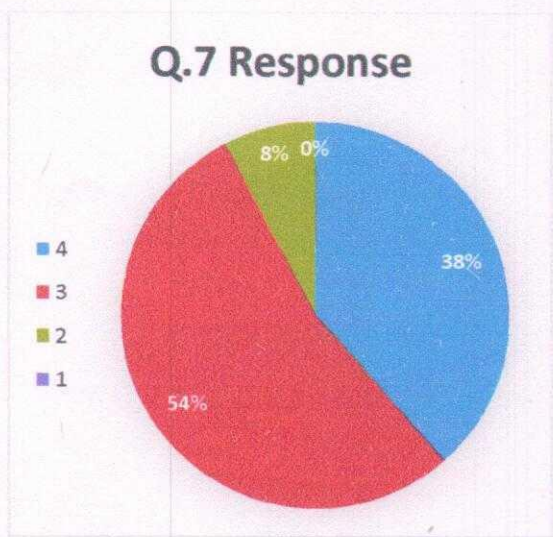
Question 6: Are you given proper opportunity to express your concern in the academic matters?


Overall Observation

1. More than 75 percent of the teachers rated 4 for the curriculum provided by the University.
2. It is imperative to witness that more than 70 percent of the teachers are satisfied with the infrastructure facility such as classroom, library and staff rooms.
3. More than 75 percent of the teachers are satisfied with the narrative of inclusive extracurricular activities such as organization of guest lectures, seminar and conferences for better understanding.

5. More than 70 percent of the teachers expressed their extreme satisfaction with respect to internet facilities provided.
