




Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?









Question 2: The syllabus provides with adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts?








Question 4: The teachers provide the students opportunities to learn and grow?










Question 5: How satisfied are you with the Teaching methodology and tools adopted by teachers for effective learning?











Question 6: Do you find the class room properly equipped to provide good atmosphere of learning along with necessary ICT tools?










Question 7: Are you satisfied with the course and reference material available in the college library?








Overall Observation

- 1. The students rated in between 4 and 5 for the balance kept in between the theoretical and practical approach in teaching methodology.
- 2. More than 70 percent of the students rated more than 3 for getting adequate knowledge of the fundamental concepts of the respective subjects.
- 3. The students are very much satisfied with the completion of the syllabus on time and rated 4 for that.
- 4. More than 65 percent of the students rated 5 for the opportunities given to learn and grow by involving students in extra-curricular activities.






Question 2: Is the infrastructure provided to you by the college in class room satisfactory?




Question 3: What is your opinion on the facilities provided to you like Library and Reading Rooms?






Question 5: How satisfied are you with the facilities given to you by the management?




Question 6: Are you given proper opportunity to express your concern in the academic matters?








3. How helpful were the teachings of college in your professional life?






5. Skills/ competencies developed during course of your study


How would rate the course that you have learnt in relation to your current work profile




7. Your overall academic experience


8. Integration of theory and practical in class


