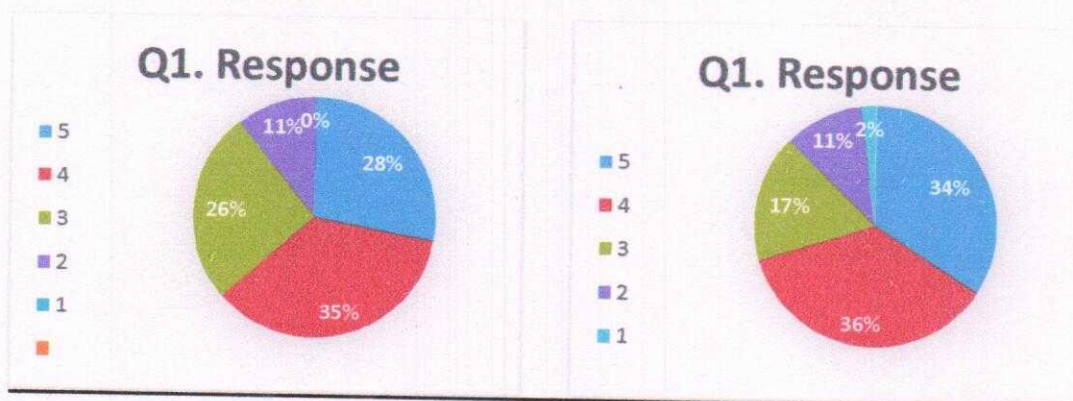

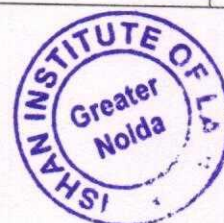

Question 1: Do you agree that the curriculum has sufficient balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?



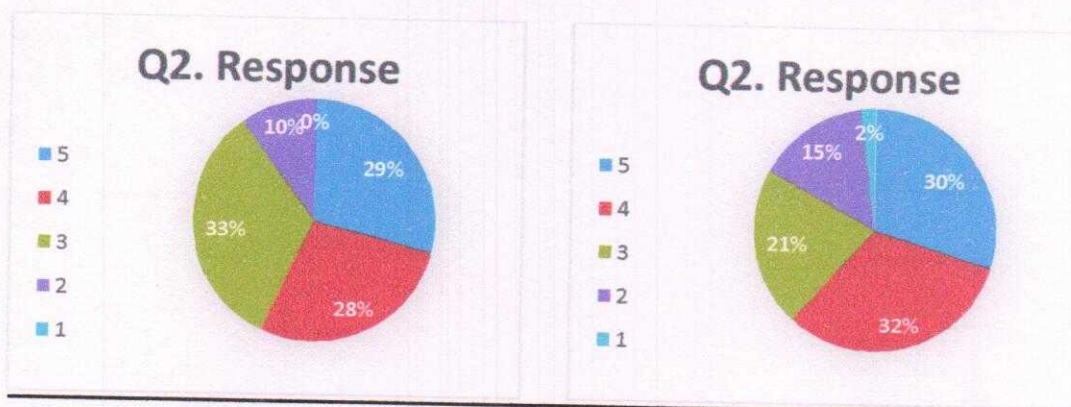

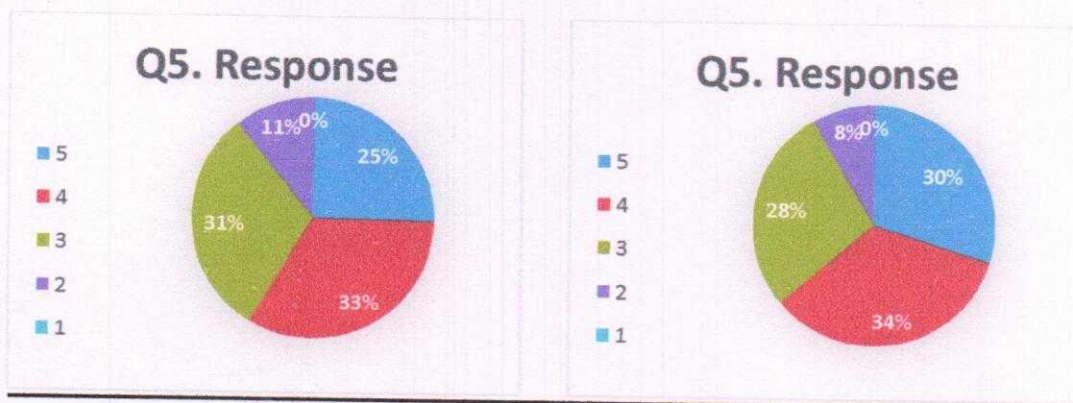

Overall Observation

1. According to the report more than 70 percent of students of all the batch rated 4 on the arrangement of practical and theoretical aspects.
2. More than 65 percent of the Students rated in between 4 and 5 on the completion of the syllabus within mentioned time framework.
3. The students looked satisfied with the teaching methodology used by the teachers by involving innovative methods and rated 4 for that.
4. More than 75 percent of the students are satisfied with the course and the reference material available in the college library and also the reading material provided by the respective Professors.



5. According to the feedback procedure conducted it was concluded that more than 70 percent of the students are given opportunities and encouragement to participate in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities such as Seminar, conference, Quiz, Moot Courts, etc.

6. Above 75 percent of the students rated 4 on given the opportunities to clear their doubts, concerns and suggestions.

Action Taken

1. Individual support to the weak students were made available to the weak students.
2. Projects on contemporary issues was given for bringing innovative approach in the Students.
3. Various guest lectures by the experts were organized for better understanding of the topics.
4. In the IT Labs more Desktop is installed for greater involvement of students with the technologies.

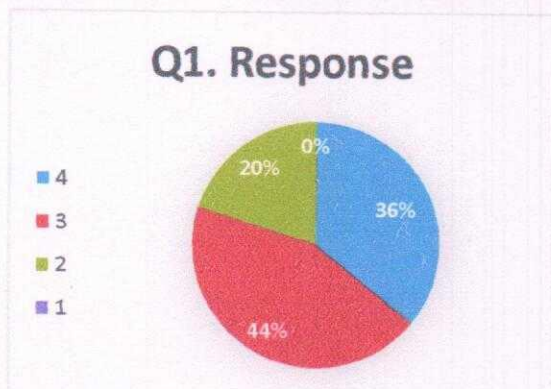

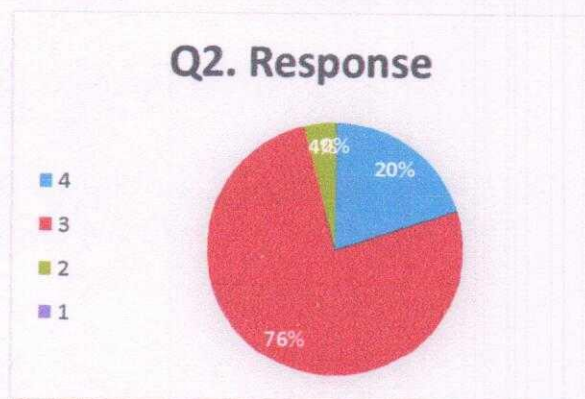

Question 1: How satisfied are you with the syllabus provided by the university?

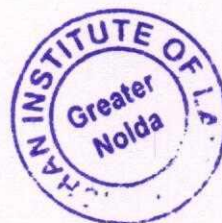

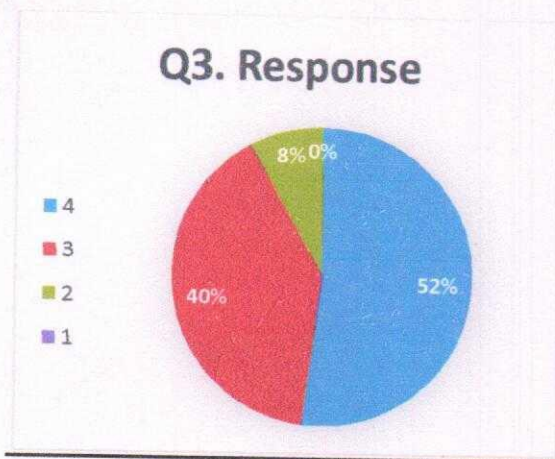
Question 2: Is the infrastructure provided to you by the college in class room satisfactory?

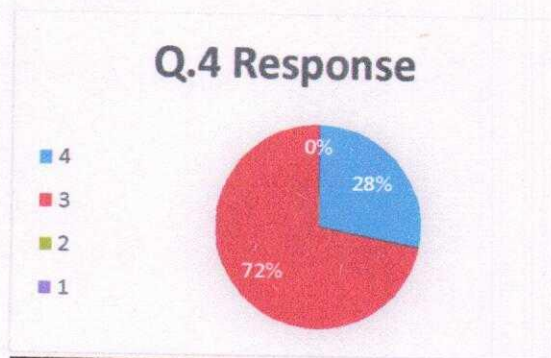


Question 3: What is your opinion on the facilities provided to you like Library and Reading Rooms?

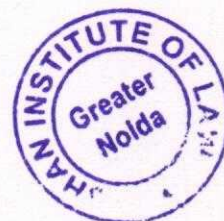

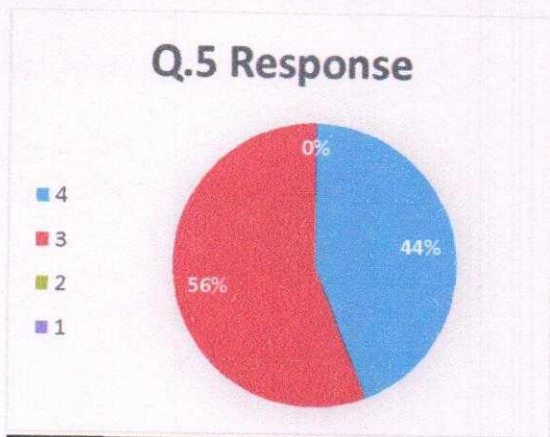
Question 4: According to you, are the co-curricular activities designed during the year appropriate?

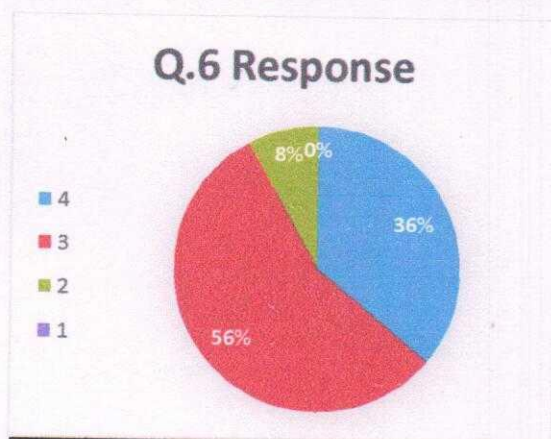


Question 5: How satisfied are you with the facilities given to you by the management?

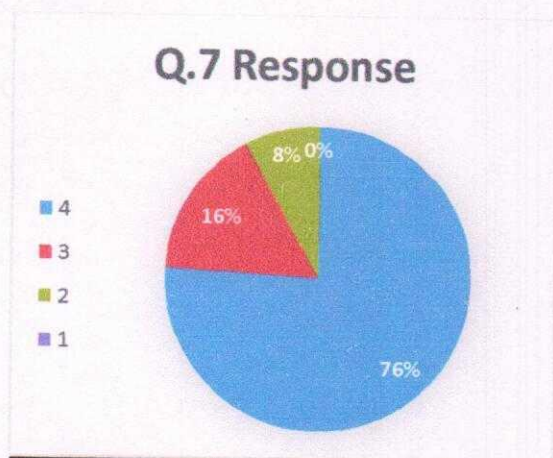
Question 6: Are you given proper opportunity to express your concern in the academic matters?

Question 7: How satisfied are you with the computer and internet facilities in the campus?



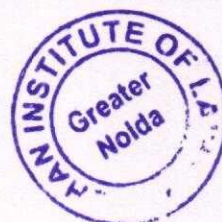

Overall Observation

1. More than 75 percent of the teachers shown their satisfaction on the curriculum provided by the University but
2. It is great to acknowledge that more than 70 percent of the teachers are satisfied with the infrastructure facility such as classroom, library and staff rooms.
3. The teachers are satisfied with the inclusive approach of the extra-curricular activities in the academic program.
4. Teachers are satisfied with the area on expressing the concern and rated in between 3 and 4.
5. More than 70 percent of the teachers expressed their extreme satisfaction with respect to internet facilities provided by the institute.

Action Taken

1. More experienced faculty of specific subjects were appointed.
2. Teachers are given more facilities such as online database, increase in incentives for extra classes, recognition for the contribution in research, etc.
3. Separate Cabins were arranged for providing ease at work and for creating positive work environment.
4. The authority of the institution opened the room for discussion and raising concerns by removing barriers between top level authority and teachers.



EMPLOYER'S REPORT

Employer Survey was circulated to all the individual Employers. Since majority of the students choose to go for Litigation or run their business, Employer Survey is not applicable for them. Some replied through confidential Letter. The observation and action taken are based on the same.

OVERALL OBSERVATION

3. To encourage researching approach projects were given to the students.



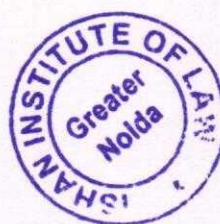

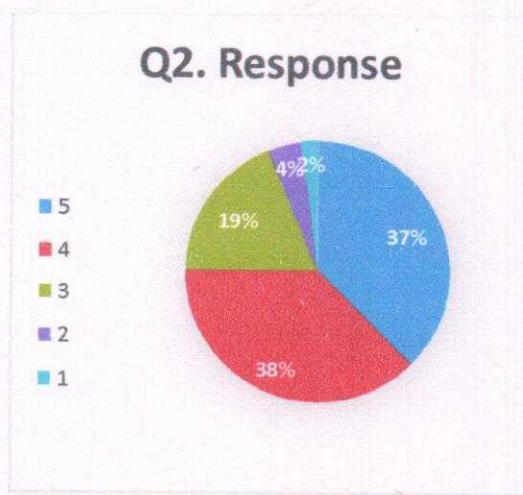

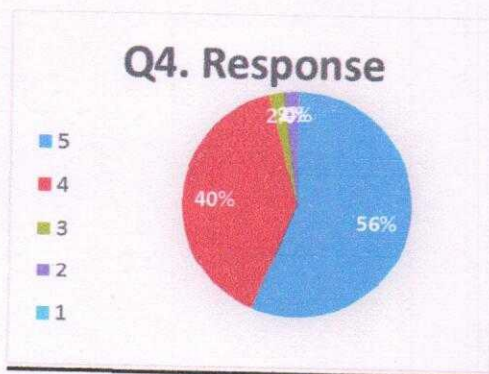


3. How helpful were the teachings of college in your professional life?

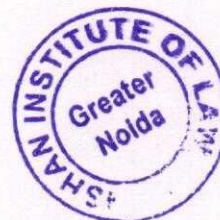

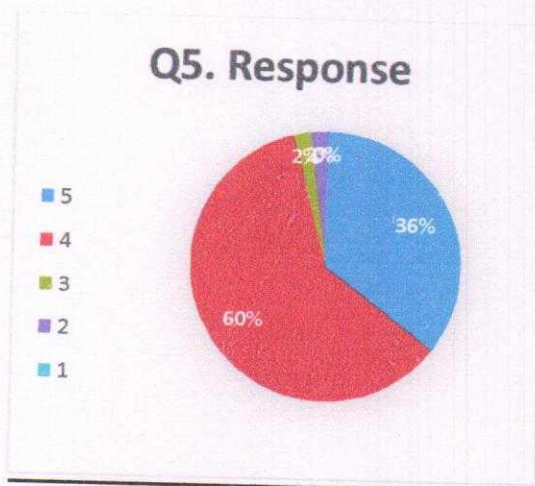
4. Development activities and programs organised by the college for your overall development?

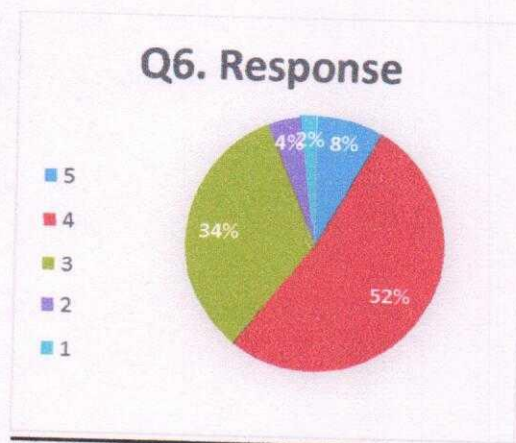


5. Skills/ competencies developed during course of your study

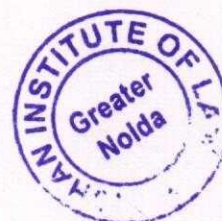

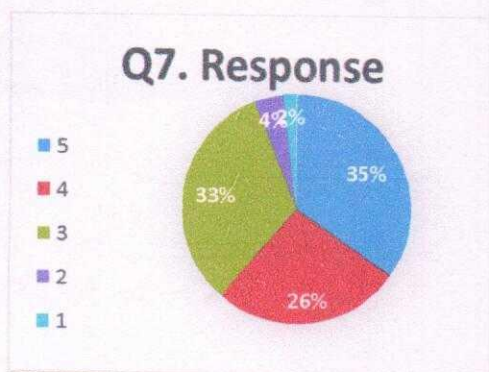
6. How would rate the course that you have learnt in relation to your current work profile

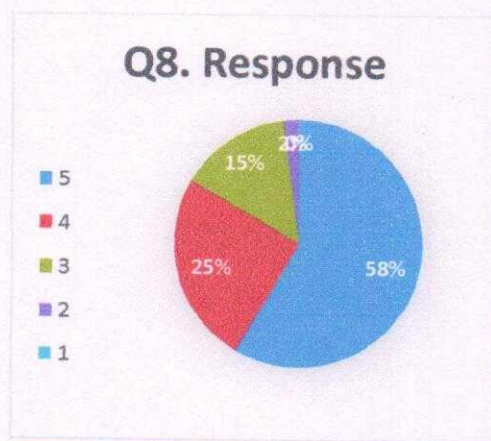

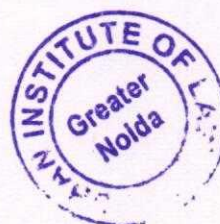

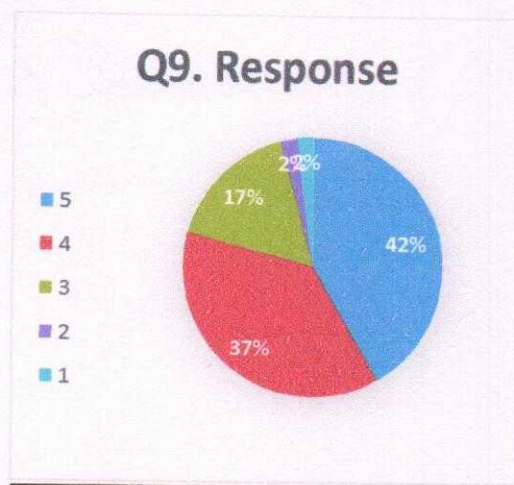
8. Integration of theory and practical in class

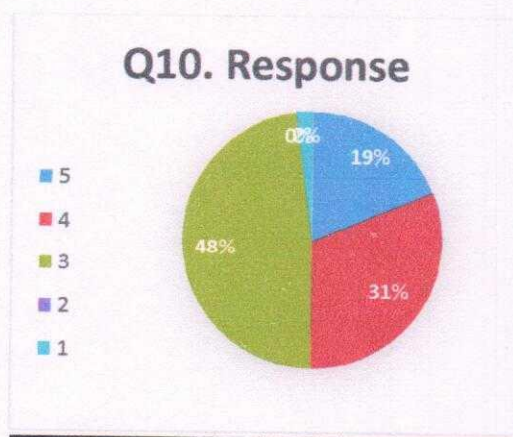


9. Availability of online resources and library digital resources & reading material support

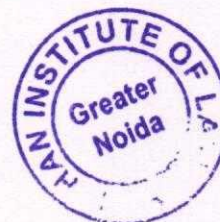


Overall Experience
